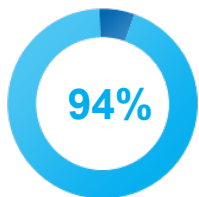

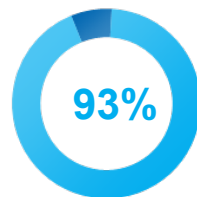
Mir Stekla 2021 welcomed 19 newcomers

One of them was a new Belarusian Glass Company, which includes four glassworks:

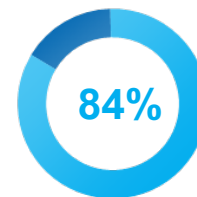
- Gomelglass (heat polished large format flat glass)

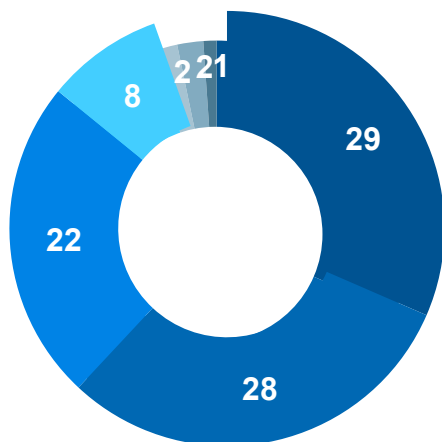

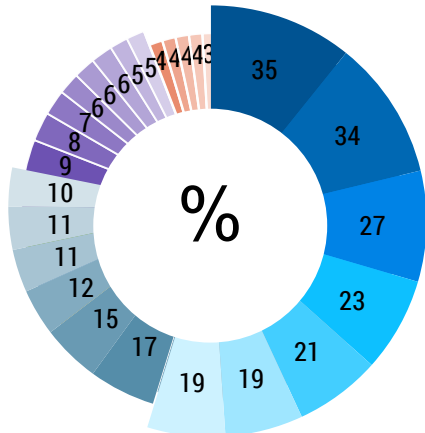
